ONLINE ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. Find the link on our website www.centralfloridafair.com select Competitive Exhibits and choose what competition to enter.
- 2. Click the large banner that says, "Click Here to Register Online".
- 3. Go to Login (on the left) and choose Exhibitor as the type of account (you will have to create a new account even if you entered online last year). Choose the option "I am a new Exhibitor". If you have to make changes after you've registered select, "I have previously registered".
- 4. Follow the steps to complete your entries, print your receipt, and you're done!

EXHIBITOR CHECK IN

FOOD ARTS & SCIENCES GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The same Exhibitor may enter TWO items in each numbered class.

2. An entry may compete in ONLY one class.

3. A numbered tag with a detachable stub is attached to every individual entry delivered in person. This stub is your receipt and must be surrendered when you claim your exhibit. SEE THAT YOU GET A STUB FOR EACH ARTICLE ENTERED.

4. The judges may elect to break a specific class into two or more if the type and quality of entries so warrant, and to award prizes based on the new class structure.

5. If there is an absence of competition, or if the exhibits are inferior in quality, only such awards will be made as, in the discretion of the judges, the exhibit merits. Only one item entered in a Division/Class does not constitute a first place.

6. The same exhibitor may make only two entries in each numbered class. An entry may compete in one class only.

7. The use of copyrighted characters, logos, or other materials is prohibited. No commercial exhibits will be accepted in this department.

8. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure they are entered in the correct age division. For Youth and Child categories, the responsible adult should assist them in entering their items. Failure to do so may cause the exhibitor to be disgualified.

9. Adult divisions are open to residents and visitors to the state of Florida at the time of the Fair. Youth and Children's divisions are open only to residents of Florida at the time of the Fair.

10. Children's division is open to Exhibitors 11 years and younger at time of Fair. Youth division is open to Exhibitors 12-17 years old at time of the Fair. 11. The Central Florida Fair reserves the right to reject any entry not considered suitable, being too large, heavy or small to be displayed properly, or being in non-compliance with these rules and regulations.

12. Exhibitors must follow any special requirements listed under any individual division.

13. Prizes and ribbons may be supplemented by merchandise awards, based on contributions from commercial concerns. "Best in Show" awards will be awarded at the judges' discretion.

14. Decisions of the judges will be final.

15. Any items entered into the Food Arts & Sciences Exhibit may be photographed and used by the Central Florida Fair for advertising.

16. The Central Florida Fair will take every precaution for the safety of all entries, but will not be responsible for loss of or damage to any entry, or for personal injury that is the result of Exhibitor's participation in the Central Florida Fair.

17. Judges will disqualify foods that haven't been appropriately cooked, refrigerated, preserved, or protected against spoilage.

18. Any items entered into the competition may be photographed and used by the Central Florida Fair for advertising.

Special requirements:

1. Three quarters of a cake or pie will be eligible for entry and will be judged on the same basis as a whole.

2. Four cookies, candies, rolls, etc., are required for entry.

3. A whole loaf of bread must be entered. Loaf cakes may be baked in either loaf or funnel pan.

4. Microwave baking acceptable.

5. Baked goods must be on disposable plates. No glass plates accepted.

6. No ready mixes allowed.

7. Please include recipe with your entry. All recipes will become property of the Central Florida Fair and may be used by the Fair for promotional purposes.
