

Horticulture Competition

Rules & Regulations

Online Pre-registration is required

Exhibitors are expected to grow and care for their plant(s). The competition will showcase and recognize individual achievement in plant growth and care. Plants grown by persons other than the exhibitor are strictly prohibited from entry into the Horticulture Competition.

REGISTRATION

All entry forms for The Central Florida Fair Horticulture Competition must be received by 5:00 pm on February 10, 2025. **Exhibitors are required to Pre-register online**. Should you need assistance please contact Megan Tolan. <u>megan@centralfloridafair.com</u>

ONLINE ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. Find the link on our website <u>www.centralfloridafair.com</u> select **Competitive Exhibits** and choose what competition to enter.
- 2. Click the large banner that says "Click Here to Register Online".
- 3. Go to Login (on the left) and choose Exhibitor as the type of account (you will have to create a new account even if you entered online last year). Choose the option "I am a new exhibitor". If you have to make changes after you've registered select, "I have previously registered".
- 4. Follow the steps to complete your entries, print your receipt, and you're done!
- 5. Any items entered into the Horticulture Competition may be photographed and used the Central Florida Fair for advertising.

Junior: 5-11 years old, Intermediate: 12-14 years old, Senior: 15-18 years old, Adult: 19 and up

EXHIBITOR CHECK IN

Entries will be accepted during the following dates and times:

Saturday, February 22, 2	025 10:00 am – 4:00 PM
Sunday, February 23, 20	025 1:00 pm – 4:00 PM

Entries must be picked up at the same location on: (Entries CANNOT be picked up early!) Monday, March 10, 2025 10:00 am - 2:00 pm

A numbered tag with detachable stub is attached to each individual entry. This stub is your receipt and must be surrendered when you claim your exhibit. BE SURE THAT YOU RECEIVE A STUB FOR EACH ARTICLE ENTERED.

PLANT ELIGIBILTY

All plants must be <u>purchased and paid for</u> by *the Exhibitor* and be in his or her possession **90 days prior** to check in. The plants must be grown at home or personally cared for in a nursery. Each Exhibitor is eligible to enter more than one entry per section/class; given each entry is a different species, Varity or type. Plants entered on the official entry form must be the same plants Exhibitor checks in at the Central Florida Fair.

Plants will be graded and inspected at entry time. All plant material must be high quality, free from insects and diseases and of a marketable size. Containers shall be attractive and clean. Containers must be of the following acceptable sizes –

4" or 6" container (1 gallon) 8" or 10" container (3 gallon)

RESTRICTIONS

The Horticulture Judges reserve the right to reject exhibits of inferior quality and diseased plants. The following criteria will be the basis for accepting and rejecting entries.

A) Freedom from insects, disease, nutritional stress and excessive cold injury;

B) Sufficiently rooted in the container.

C) Acceptable size for the container based on the competition entered.

<u>Please note</u> that all prize money awarded in connection with the Horticulture Exhibits shall be cashed by the recipient within 90 days from that date of the check. If the recipient fails to timely negotiate said check, all monies due recipient shall be considered a contribution to the Central Florida Fair by the recipient. Any disputes regarding premium awards must be reported to the Fair Office by March 31st, 2023. The Fair does not guarantee payment of additional premiums if notification is not received by that date. (No exceptions!)

Entered items may not be more than four (4) feet in any direction Entered items must have aesthetically pleasing design, variety of plants, and contrast of color. **Collections** must be six different species of one genre, Container. **Terrariums** must have lids.
